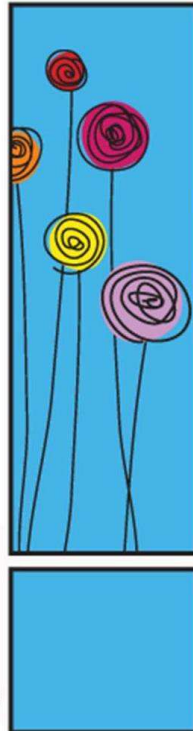

Small Groups and Teams

P.A.L.S. – Prayer, Action, Learning, Sharing

At All Saints we believe that in small groups we can get to know people on a level that is not possible in the larger community. Small groups offer an opportunity for fellowship, spiritual growth, support and even accountability.

Ministry teams are groups of people that work in a wide variety of ways to contribute to the ongoing life of our parish.

Both Small Groups and Ministry teams operate using the **P.A.L.S.** acronym:

Prayer – growing in meditation and prayer, and offering support to each other through prayer.

Action – Reaching out in concrete acts of justice and service to help meet the needs of members with in and outside the group.

Learning – This might simply be a shared area of interest or affinity. It should contribute to each member's personal growth and to a deeper knowledge of God.

Sharing – Developing meaningful friendships with other group member, with trust being an essential component.

On the information table you will find a booklet listing many of the groups and teams operating here at All Saints. We are always delighted to form new groups. What are you passionate about? What would you like to learn more about? What are convenient meeting times for you? Are you looking for fellowship? These are just a few things to consider when thinking about a small group.
